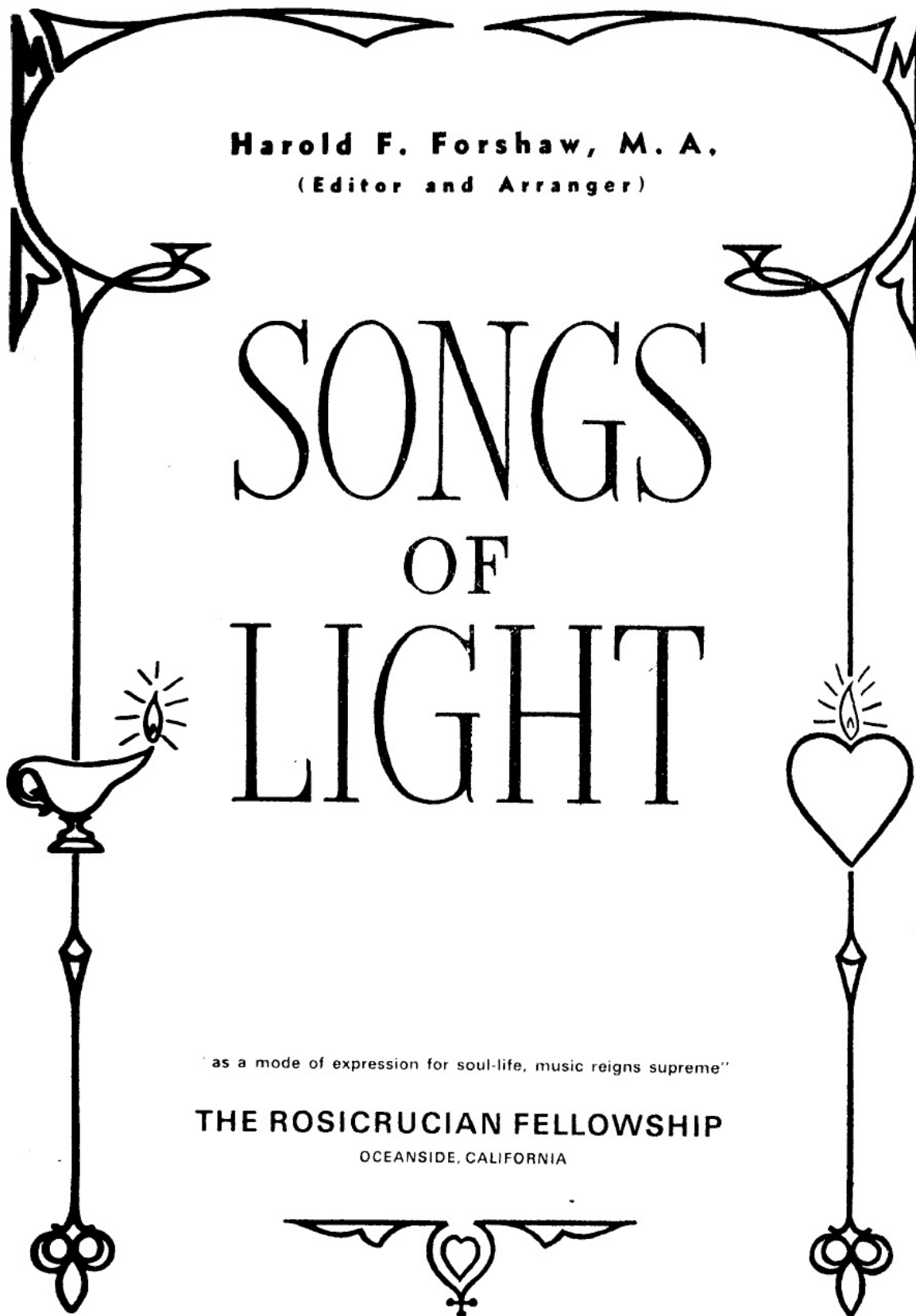

SOME SUGGESTIONS

- The zodiacal songs may be used for every service, in their order, according to the sign through which the sun is passing.
- The White Rose Service Song should be sung, when the white rose is placed in the Emblem, during healing services.
- When used in Sunday School, the Rosicrucian Emblem Song may be sung with motions—the congregation standing.
- At the words: "I make the living cross," stretch arms out at sides, level with shoulders.
